## ARTBOX.PROJECT Basel 2.0 KEY FACTS

### How does the ARTBOX.PROJECT Basel 2.0 work?

- Register your artwork at [www.artboxprojects.com](http://www.artboxprojects.com) (Deadline 30 April 2023)
- Pay the participation fee of EUR 45 per artwork. You have the possibility to choose between credit card or PayPal as payment option.
- Your artwork will be **digitally** displayed on one of the two 55" 4K HD screens during the ARTBOX.PROJECT Basel 2.0 exhibition.
- You will receive an official certificate of participation and a picture of your artwork on the screen.
- IN ADDITION, you have the chance to be selected as a finalist or semi-finalist. However, **ALL artworks will be presented digitally, not only the finalists and semi-finalists.**

### Where and when will ARTBOX.PROJECT Basel 2.0 take place?

ARTBOX.PROJECT Basel 2.0 will take place from 15 - 18 June 2023 during Art Basel Week at Basel Airport.

- **Where:** Basel Airport Mulhouse / Switzerland-Basel Area

### What do the finalists get?

**Important: ALL ARTISTS WILL RECEIVE A DIGITAL PRESENTATION DURING THE SHOW, NOT ONLY THE FINALISTS!**

The original artworks of the 10 finalists will be exhibited during ARTBOX.PROJECT Basel 2.0 from 15 - 18 June 2023. Only the finalist artist's artwork will be shown originally in Basel, the rest of the registered artworks will be shown digitally on the 55" screens together with the other participants. The transportation costs of the finalist artworks to the exhibition and back to the artist (excluding

artwork packaging!) as well as the on-site services will be covered by ARTBOX.PROJECTS. In summary, the on-site services include the following:

- An exhibition space for the finalist artwork including installation and suspension of the artwork
- Support by sales staff during the entire exhibition
- Labelling of the exhibition space according to the standards of ARTBOX.PROJECTS
- Creation of a personalised QR code that leads directly to the artist's website
- It is mandatory that the finalist artwork be packaged as follows:
  - in a wooden box with the standard ISPM-15, without this standard we cannot transport any works
  - Maximum weight of the box 10 kg
  - the crate must be able to be opened at the front and must imperatively be closed with screws, nails are not allowed

### **What do the semi-finalists receive?**

- The artworks of the 20 semi-finalists will not be exhibited as originals. The artworks of the 20 semi-finalists will also be shown on the two 55" screens.
- In addition, a personal art catalogue will be produced for each semi-finalist, which will be shown live during the exhibition. In this catalogue, the semi-finalists will have the opportunity to present more of their artworks to the visitors. Furthermore, all semi-finalists will receive 10 copies of their catalogue free of charge for their own use.

### **Other important questions:**

- **Will there be any additional costs?** No, there will be no additional costs for you after registration!
- **Commission if work is sold during the exhibition:** If your artwork is sold during ARTBOX.PROJECT Basel 2.0, we do not take any commission. The sales price goes 100% to you!
- **Who can participate?** Our art project is open to all artists, regardless of nationality or style.
- **How many artworks can you submit?** You can submit as many artworks as you want! There is no limit.
